#### Academic excellent criteria. All documents should be submitted in PDF format.

A student who has already enrolled in a college and or university with at least a **CGPA of 3.3.** o A student who has graduated from **Senior High School (SHS)** in Ghana and has obtained an official admission letter to an accredited college and or a university.

- SHS must have at least **4As and 4Bs from the WAEC examination**.
- University Academic documents:
  - Submit admission letter, transcript, tuition sheet, and housing/hostel fee official university letterhead and housing official letterhead for authenticity.
  - Personal essay.
  - **Recommendation letters**: List three (3) recommenders' email addresses and names during the online application process. They will be sent an online recommendation form directly for them to complete. The recommenders must comprise:
    - Two (2) recommenders from your college and or university, and high school
    - One (1) from a friend or professional relations.
- Need-based criteria: A student whose parents combined monthly income is less than 600ghc (\$50) and a student with a single parent making a monthly income of less than 400ghc (\$32) in Ghana meet this criterion.

• **Parent/Guardian Information**: Parent and or guardian financial information such as SNNIT, bank account and or pension document if applicable, and pictures for traders.

### All documents must be submitted in PDF format.

Please apply only if you fulfill all these criteria:

1. Academic excellent criteria You must be enrolled in a college or university with at least a CGPA of 3.3 Or

You must have graduated from Senior High School (SHS) in Ghana *with* **at least 4As and 4Bs from the WAEC** examination *and* obtained an official admission letter to an accredited college or university.

Please submit these college- or university-related documents:

- a. Admission letter on your institution's official letterhead
- b. Housing or hostel rents, on the housing authority's official letterhead
- c. Official Transcript and WAEC scores
- d. Official tuition sheet.
- 2. Need-based criteria

For a student dependent on two parents (or guardians), the parents' (or guardians') combined monthly income should be less than 600 GHC (\$80) in Ghana

For a student dependent on one parent (or guardian), that single parent's (or guardian's) monthly income should be less than 400 GHC (\$50) in Ghana.

Please submit one or more of these documents to support monthly income data:

- a. SNNIT (Social Security and National Insurance Trust)
- b. Bank account statement
- c. Pension document
- d. Substitute pictures above documents for traders and farmers.

# You must also submit:

- 3. Three (3) recommenders' names and active email addresses, they should comprise of:
  - a. Two (2) official letters from teachers/lecturers in your college or university, and or high school
  - b. One (1) letter from a friend or professional relations (**Family excluded**)
  - c. Personal picture in a Jpeg format
- 4. A personal essay.
